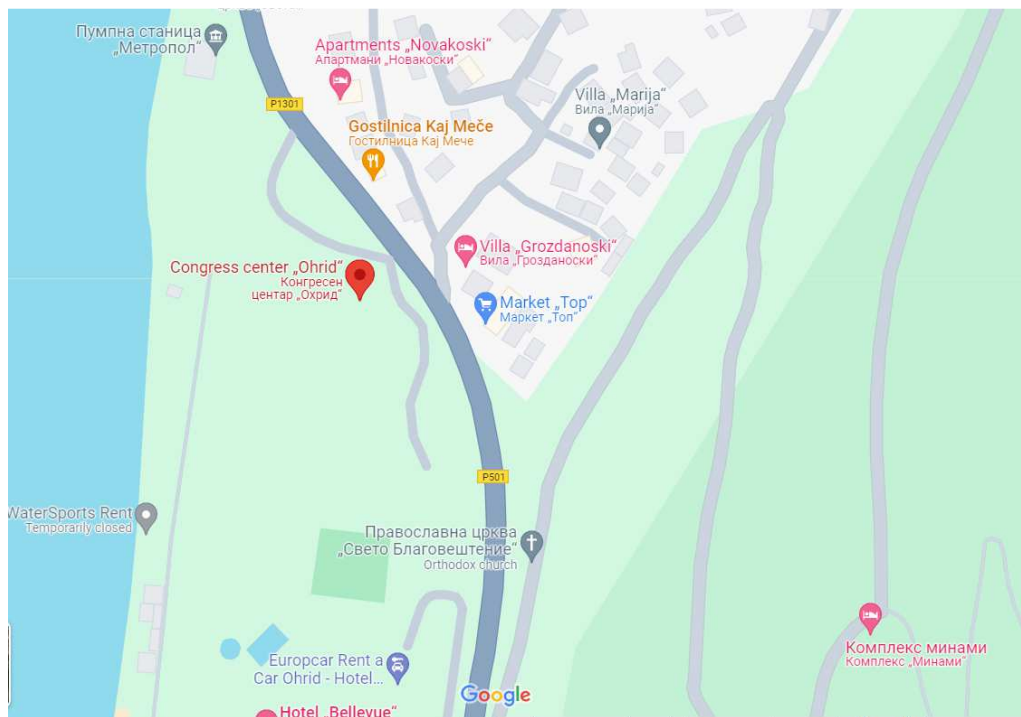

Getting there

Congress Center is located on the shore of the Lake Ohrid, around 6 km from the city of Ohrid.

By car

From Ohrid

Congress Center is located on the road leading from the city of Ohrid toward the St. Naum Monastery and the border with Albania.

From Skopje

Take the A2 (E65) from Skopje to Ohrid. Once in Ohrid, take the boulevard Turisticka across the city, following the signs for St. Naum. The road has pay tolls, totaling to 140 denars, that can be payed in denars, with credit card or in EUR.

By plane

Ohrid airport

Ohrid has an international airport located just 9 km outside of the city. The timetable for the Ohrid airport can be found here

Skopje airport

Skopje Airport is located 17 km outside of the city of Skopje. More information about the airport can be found here

From Skopje Airport to the city of Skopje, there is shuttle bus service, with timetable available here <https://skp.airports.com.mk/en-EN/passenger-guide/to-from-the-airport/page/bus>

If you use the shuttle bus, and want to continue toward Ohrid by bus, step down from the bus at the Central Bus Station in Skopje.

By bus

Ohrid main bus station can be reached from many cities around the region.

From Skopje Central Bus Stations, there are 10+ busses daily leaving to Ohrid. More info on <https://ruleturs.techinreact.com/?SearchCity>

(We recommend using the “МАКЕДОНИЈА СООБРАЌАЈ” or “ГАЛЕБ ОХРИД” busses, since they are more comfortable). The bus takes around 3 and a half hour to reach Ohrid bus station.
